

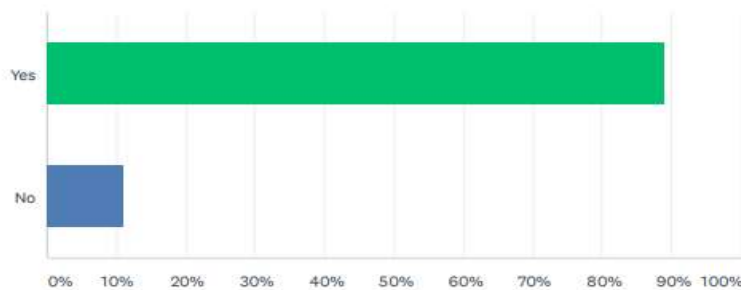
Response to survey sent out 22 / 9 / 2020

This was a very short survey to ascertain parents' views should the need arise for a class and their staff to self-isolate, as a result of a member of a bubble having tested positive for Covid 19. If this were to happen the protocol is for the school to call Public Health England and HCC who will advise us on the next steps. At school, we have very tight class bubbles with the children interacting with a limited number of adults and other children to limit the possibility of cross contamination. If a class / bubble were to be asked to stay at home this would be for 14 days and it would include the staff who have been working closely with those children.

There were a huge variety of answers to this question including:

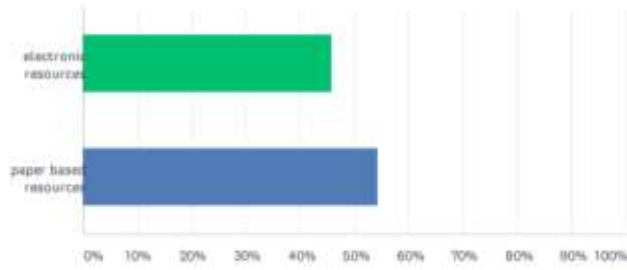
the loan of school IT equipment / photocopies of learning materials / packs similar to the work we offered during the 'lockdown' / website links / reading books / paper / zoom online lessons etc.

This is obviously very difficult as everyone's home situation is different and it depends a lot on the age of the child/ren. Unfortunately, we are not able to loan out school IT equipment as it is specifically set up to work from our school server and will not work off site, however we are currently in conversation with HCC about the loan of suitable equipment should the need arise. At present, we do not have the capability to offer online learning through a 'platform' but are currently looking into extending the use of Tapestry to parents in KS1 and 'google classrooms' for KS2 children. We recognise the need for the children to keep in touch with their teacher as they like the feedback and interaction and we are investigating methods to achieve this. Unfortunately, HCC does not recommend schools make use of Zoom as they have encountered security issues.

We are already making plans and copying paper based resources as, should the need arise to self-isolate a bubble, we will not have much time to prepare resources especially if it is the staff member who is taken ill.

Q3 Would you prefer to work with your child from electronic resources or paper based resources?

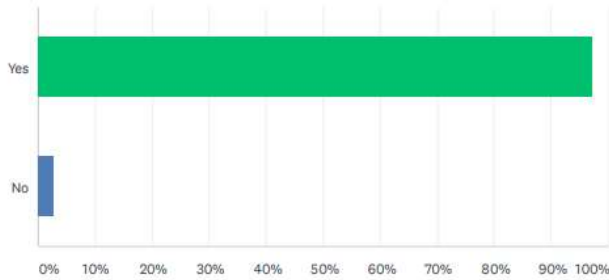

Q4 A lot of resources require the use of the Internet, do you have reliable broadband / wifi?

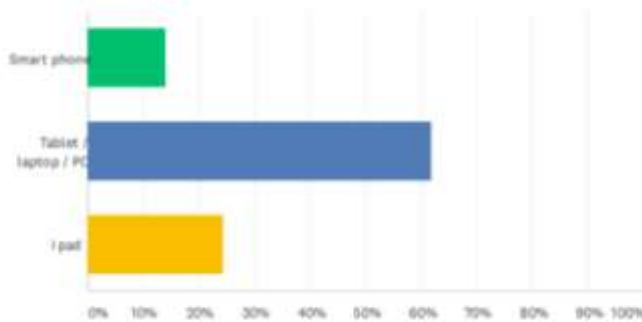
