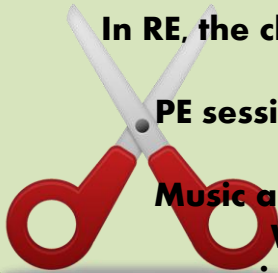
Welcome back! I hope everyone had a lovely break. Our history this term is 'The Romans in Britain' and after half term we will study Peru for geography.
