Just a reminder regarding our parent consultations:

Our first parent consultations of this academic year will take place on Friday 3rd November and Monday 6th November.

We understand that some of you will be excited to come in to school and meet your child's teacher face to face, whilst others may find it more convenient if consultations were online. We are going to try and accommodate all by offering both face to face and a limited number of online sessions across the 2 days. There will be sessions reserved for face to face appointments ONLY, there will also be sessions reserved for online appointments ONLY. Teachers will be offering 10 minute slots for each child and will be booked on a first come first serve basis.

Friday 20th October: School will be open for parents and carers to come and look at their children's books in their classrooms from 8:30 - 9:00. You will be able to move between year groups to see all of your children.

Friday 3rd November: All consultations will be face to face between 14:20 and 17:10.

Monday 6th November: Face to face appointments between 15:40 and 17:00. Online consultations from 17:25 to 18:20.

All bookings will need to be made via School Cloud and the booking system will go live on **Monday 16th October at 17:30**. We have done this to hopefully allow as many parents as possible to book a time slot that best suits them.
