Physical Development

Use large muscle movements to wave flags and streamers.
Use an effective pencil grip

Maths

Develop fast recognition of up to 4 objects. without having to count them individually.
Visually compare two groups (more than/ fewer than)
Can separate a group of objects in different ways, recognising the total stays the same.
Recite number names in sequence.

Literacy

Identify words that rhyme.
Creates play around stories.
Shares opinions about stories.
Beginning to write recognisable letters
Talk about characters from different stories.

Listen carefully and follow instructions.

Increasingly follow rules and understand why they are important.

Encourage your child to create their own stories. They could use small world characters or puppets.

Look at story books together. Can your child tell the story using the pictures?

Encourage your child to identify words that rhyme-

Read stories together and identify any words that rhyme.

Read/ sing Nursery Rhymes

Make up silly sentences with rhyming words.

Encourage your child to talk about the things that they see. What do they notice? Can they see patterns, colours, shapes or quantities?

Can they talk about places and buildings that they see around them?
